1. Welcome & Gratitude – the parents and administration did a great job for Teacher Appreciation week.
2. April minutes were approved.
3. CAAC Elections: Debbie (10th), Piper (8th or 11th), and Melinda (12th) all agreed to serve next year. Sonia will contact parents for grades 8, 9, and 11 to ask for volunteers. The volunteers will be ratified via vote in a Monday Mail. It was suggested and agreed that teacher reps should be requested when the 2022/2023 school year starts. Student council will elect their members before the end of this school year.
4. We discussed the impact of the city's 200S plans on parking in front of the school, which will be significantly decreased. The current school transportation plan should still work for next year.
